

Subject: Solicitation

Purpose:

To prevent patrons from feeling harassed or pressured when using the library.

Policy:

Library property is operated for the provision of library services to the public. As a limited public forum, the library places reasonable and viewpoint-neutral restrictions on speech on library property, including parking lots, walkways, and building interiors.

Public solicitation of any kind will not be permitted on Library property or in the Library Community Rooms, except for library related activities or as required when the library is a polling place.

No person shall be allowed to petition for signatures on library property.

No sales of any kind (raffles, ticket sales, products, services, etc.) are to be conducted in the library except when sponsored by the Library Board of Trustees, Friends of the Library, MFRL Foundation or any organization whose sole purpose is to support the library.
