#### **MFRL Mobile Library**

MFRL's new Mobile Library provides services in the community in five targeted areas: economically at-risk communities, geographically remote communities, senior communities, congregate settings for young people, and community events. At 307 scheduled stops, the Mobile Library hosted 1,344 library users.



#### Meadowbrook Library

Meadowbrook Library served eastern Montgomery with allages community events in the courtyard, school visits, and the Backpack Program, which provided around 50 families each week with healthy meals and snacks.



#### Jessie Peterman Memorial Library

Jessie Peterman Memorial Library in Floyd broke new ground in many ways, including monthly **DMV Connect** visits, partnerships with Floyd County Drug Court and the 401 Peer Center, and a Literature in the Garden series for children with Junior Master Gardeners.



#### Christiansburg Library

Christiansburg Library helped the town shake off COVID with the return of Caturday (with the Montgomery Animal Care and Adoption Center), Music on Lawn, visits to the Farmer's Market, Christiansburg Juneteenth Celebration, and local schools.

#### **Blacksburg Library**

Blacksburg Library developed enriching program partnerships the Virginia Workforce Development Office, Virginia Tech School of Visual Arts, New River Art & Fiber, Sustainable Blacksburg, Inc., the Peer **Health Educator** program, and other groups.
