

Subject: Solicitation

Purpose:

To prevent patrons from feeling harassed or pressured when using the library.

Policy:

Library property is operated for the provision of library services to the public. As a limited public forum, the library places reasonable and viewpoint-neutral restrictions on speech on library property, including parking lots, walkways, and building interiors.

Public solicitation of any kind will not be permitted on Library property or in the Library Community Rooms, except for library related activities; as required when the library is a polling place; or for purposes of signature gathering for petitions as described in MFRL 314: Signature Gathering and Civic Solicitation.

No sales of any kind (raffles, ticket sales, products, services, etc.) are to be conducted in the library except when sponsored by the Library Board of Trustees, Friends of the Library, MFRL Foundation, the Floyd County Library Building Fund, Inc., or official affiliate organizations of the Dolly Parton's Imagination Library that serve children in Montgomery or Floyd counties.


